COVID-19 Range Safety Protocols

As we have now opened the range to public events and to protect members and guests from the Covid-19 virus, the following Range Safety Protocols will now be in effect.

- 1. Sanitize your hands after opening the gate lock. Sanitizer is available at all of the benches.**
- 2. If you are sick, do not attend the range.**
- 3. Group sizes for events must be in accordance with the British Columbia Health Officer's recommendation.**
- 4. Physical distancing of 2 meters (6 feet) must be maintained. If this is not possible, then masks should be worn. The Club does not supply masks.**
- 5. Focus on practice and skill development, not competition.**
- 6. Guests of members must be made aware of these protocols and must adhere to them.**
- 7. No one on one instruction unless it is a direct family member or masks are used by both instructor and student.**
- 8. At-risk persons should not attend the facilities or public events.**
- 9. Signs will be placed to indicate social distancing requirements.**
- 10. Cleaning supplies are provided at all benches. Sanitize all club equipment before and after each use. Please do not shoot at these supplies and do not remove them from the area.**
- 11. Hand sanitizer is provided at all benches and should be used by all persons when arriving at the site. Please do not shoot at these supplies and do not remove them from the area.**
- 12. Clean all bench areas and chairs before use.**
